Request for Submissions: 30th Rabin Memorial Day Poster Contest

1.Contest Details

- Submission Deadline: July 30 12:00 pm Israel time
- Announcement of Winners: During August 2025
- Poster Distribution Begins: During September 2025 (ahead of the official memorial day)

<u>Selected posters will be available for Jewish institutions and individuals globally, allowing them to showcase Rabin's vision and values in their communities.</u>

2. Conditions of participation

The competition is open to Jewish adults (18+) from diaspora communities worldwide! Professional artists and creative enthusiasts alike are welcome to participate. Submit one poster either individually or as a group—no formal training required, just your unique artistic perspective and passion for visual storytelling.

1. Themes for Poster Design

Artists are encouraged to submit original artwork that reflects one of the following themes:

- 1. "Dare to Dream" Inspired by Rabin's vision for a better future, this theme encourages reflection on democracy, peace, and Jewish unity.
- 2. **"Democracy, Peace, Security"** Rabin's leadership pillars. How do we uphold these values today?
- 3. "Justice & Security" Exploring the balance between protecting Jewish communities and striving for justice and solidarity.
- 4. "Light in the Darkness" A universal message of hope and resilience in challenging times.
- 5. "One People, Many Voices" Emphasizing unity despite ideological and political differences.

3.Poster Requirements

- **Size:** 18 x 24 inches (Vertical Format)
- **Medium:** Digital or print-ready artwork (high-resolution, 300 dpi)
- **Submission Format:** PDF or PNG, with a short artist's statement (up to 250 words)

4. Compensation & Awards

- Selected artists (10) will receive \$200 for their submissions.
- The top three(3) winning designs will receive an additional \$540 each.
- Posters will be distributed globally, giving artists international exposure.
